We had a really nice Zoom meeting earlier this month, 17 SNAIL members and one guest attend the June 4th first-ever SNAIL meeting

online. Like most Zoom meetings, it was a little awkward at first, making sure cameras and microphones would work. We touched base with everyone and each shared their experiences with the quarantine. Once everyone had the chance to speak up, we jumped into the content of the meeting. It was well appreciated by all in attendance.

We addressed some of the city news that affects SNAIL; mainly, the fact that the City canceled all dumpsters programs this year and moved the National Night Out event from August to October 6th. This is not a definite date, as the final decision will be made based on the COVID-19 impact and outcome on the community.

The final comments were on the following two topics:

- 1. **Guest Speakers:** unanimously the participants in attendance requested guest speakers at future and upcoming zoom meetings.
- 2. Candidate Forum: as many of you may remember from announcements in prior newsletters, we had reserved the community room in the Fair Oaks Park for the SNAIL organized the Candidate Forum for October 22, 2020 and Elaine Manley Co-President of The Cupertino-Sunnyvale League of Women Voters (LWV) agreed to be once again our moderator. During the June SNAIL meeting, it was suggested that we may want to look into organizing an online Candidate Forum since voting in California starts early and in light of COVID-19 situation that may still be an issue in October. After checking with her chapter, our moderator agreed to be hosting a candidate forum on September 10th.
