Report Graffiti In Progress!

Graffiti in our neighborhood has been painted by rival gangs. Allowing graffiti only invites more. Officer Jim Davis requested at our last meeting that we immediately dial 911 if we see someone painting graffiti in the neighborhood. Do not be shy about calling 911 if you see suspicious persons and suspect vandalism is about to occur or has just occurred. This is the most effective way for police to ID suspects. Try to remember an accurate description of the suspects. If you are just reporting graffiti after the taggers have left the area, call the graffiti hotline at 730-7680 so the graffiti will get promptly cleaned up.

Sunnyvale's Neighborhood Preservation Division September 21, 2010

Dear Sunnyvale Community Members:

In September 2009 the Neighborhood Preservation (NP) Program (code enforcement) moved from the Community Development Department to the Department of Public Safety (DPS). The move is designed to facilitate quicker and better access to police and fire personnel resulting in NP staff resolving more serious problems at individual properties and in targeted neighborhoods.

The innovative but standard practice in DPS is for staff to regularly rotate through different assignments in an effort to resolve issues with a new and fresh perspective. With that in mind, our NP staff will rotate their jurisdictions effective October 1, 2010.
