I care a lot about Sunnyvale so I pay attention to what the city is working on. Each year Sunnyvale decides which new ideas or changes city staff will work on. I wanted to let you know that in January and February, the city holds workshops on the study issues so you can become familiar with them. Then, in late February the city council makes its final cut on which ideas to drop, defer or do in 2015. Influencing which issues our city studies is the first step in making changes. Please look at the list and let your city council members know which ones you think are important and which ones to drop or defer. You can provide feedback directly to the mayor via a survey he has on his website: <http://tinyurl.com/StudyIssuesSurvey>.

Our February guest speakers are Neighborhood Officer Brian Gantt and Lt. Ryan Yin. They will be explaining the neighborhood watch program to us.

Another meeting of note: on Feb 24<sup>th</sup>, the Sunnyvale city council will be making its recommendations to VTA about VTA's proposal to add Bus Rapid Transit to El Camino Real all the way from San Jose to San Francisco. There are seven different alternatives to choose from. Putting dedicated bus lanes through Sunnyvale is included in a couple of those alternatives and would be the most important change to El Camino Real since it was paved. ### Brief Summary of January Meeting Minutes

•**Guest Speaker:** Michael Alba, LinkedIn Global Transportation Manager. Michael discussed LinkedIn's transportation methods and ways that they are working to help with the flow of traffic in the Maude and Mathilda intersection. They are cutting down the number of cars employees are using by providing incentives for bikes, trains and carpooling.

•**SNAIL Secretary Elections:** Nominations opened for Secretary - Ali Stephens volunteered to fill the position. Voted on and unanimously approved. Sarah has agreed to continue as acting Secretary until Ali has met her eligibility requirement which is expected to be in March.

Our streets are generally swept every two weeks on the day following your trash pickup. If possible, please move your car off the street on street sweeping days. This month, the street sweeping schedule is:


